Community Connectedness Inventory. Students were asked to think about a typical graduate course at UW, our seminar classroom, and their primary workplace on campus. For each, they rated a set of statements, with 1 being not at all true and 5 being entirely true. For each space, ratings were then summed to yield a score between 0 and 60.
